**Customer Information on Recyclability of Packaging Products according to PTS-RH 021/97 (2012)
Category II “PFR that are predominantly used in the manufacture of packaging papers”.**

For the purpose of achieving recyclability, the mills of Stora Enso Division Packaging Materials constantly analyze their own products against PTS-RH 021/97 and other recycling methods.

The PTS method has been prepared by the subcommittee “Recycling criteria of recovered paper utilization” of the ZELLCHEMING Technical Committee RECO in close consultation with the recycled fiber processing industry in Germany. The PTS method aims to simulate an industrial recycling process and focus on technological and quality parameters of the final products.

Recyclability is defined so that paper and board, and the products made with them, are considered as being recyclable in a paper or board mill if the cellulose fibers of which they are made of lead to an effective and efficient production from a technological and economic point of view using defined, specified and widely used standard equipment and current paper and board making technologies in order to produce new paper or board of a quality that suits to the needs of the markets.

Based on our current knowledge and recyclability testing on representative samples of the paperboard we hereby state that the below listed paperboard grade before conversion is recyclable according to PTS-RH 021/97 (2012). According to the material identification codes as defined in PPWD 97/129/EC the below listed paperboard grade before conversion can be classified as PAP-21.
